



Blue's Clues Drum Craft

Supplies

- Round Paper Box (or small box of any shape you have at home)
- Baby and Royal Blue Craft Paint
- Paint Brushes • Twine
- Hot Glue • Wooden Beads
- Wooden Dowel (a pencil also works)
- Clue Paw Print Template

Instructions

1. Cut a hole in the bottom of your box large enough to fit wooden dowel (or pencil) inside.
2. Poke 2 small holes on either side of the box for the twine.
3. Paint your dowel and the top and bottom of your box a baby blue color.
4. Paint around the edge of your box with royal blue paint.
5. Insert the wooden dowel (or pencil) into your box and use hot glue inside the box to hold the dowel in place.
6. Thread twine through the holes in either side and knot on the inside of box to hold twine in place. (Add hot glue on top of the knot to make this extra secure.)
7. Glue on top of the box or glue closed the box flaps, depending on the box used.
8. Choose the "clue" paw print that is the best size for your box lid and trace it, pressing hard enough to leave a slight indentation on top of the box.
9. Fill in the paw print, using the indentation as your guide, with royal blue paint.
10. Knot the twine on either side of box, add wooden beads, then knot again to hold the beads in place
11. Make sure you size the twine so the beads will hit at approximately the center of your box lid when it's used.
12. Spin the Den Den Drum back and forth to create music!
